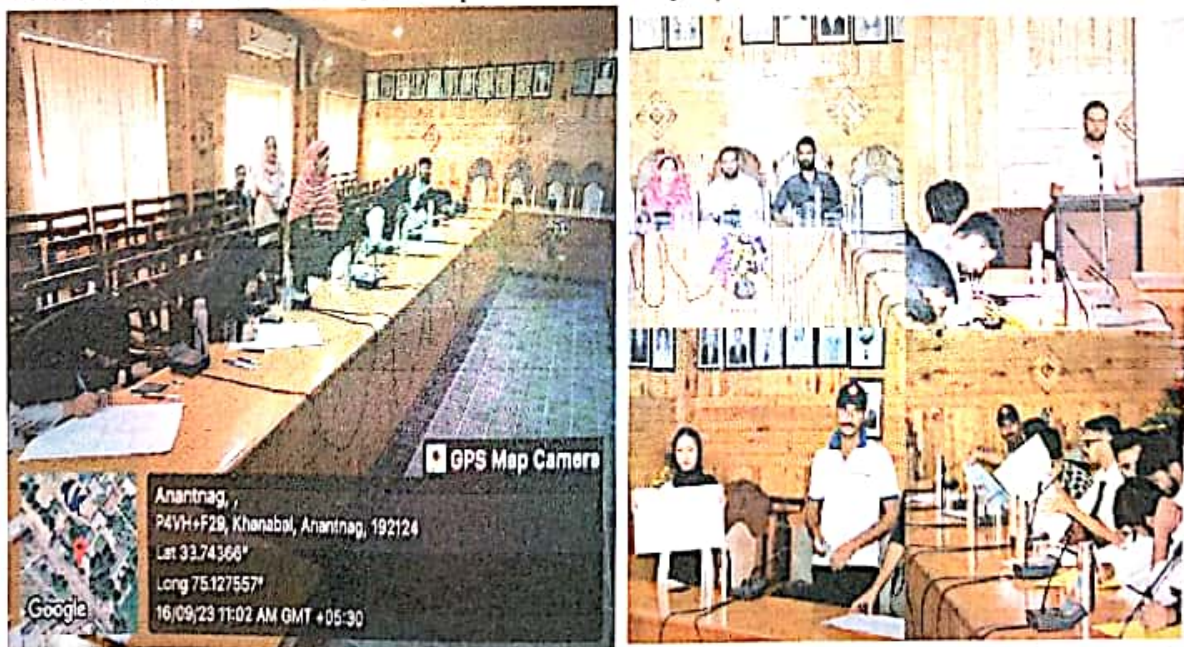


The main goal of this program was to enlighten our students about the core principles of Gandhian Philosophy, emphasizing Truth and Non-Violence. Mahatma Gandhi ardently opposed war and advocated Non-Violence as the means to attain justice and peace. He firmly believed that Truth and Non-Violence were

inseparable, with Non-Violence being the means and Truth being the ultimate goal. Gandhi contended that societal ills, such as violence, tyranny, and injustice, arose due to a disregard for the pervasive and all-encompassing truth. He asserted that combating evil with evil, violence with violence, and anger with anger only fuelled the flames.



Truth and Non-Violence were, in Gandhi's eyes, the most potent forces against these societal maladies. According to him, negative emotions like anger, pride, selfishness, and hatred were at the root of harm to life. He believed that all individuals were interconnected, sharing a common origin and destiny, fundamentally the same. Gandhi's only weapons against these social issues were Truth and Non-Violence, concepts he staunchly upheld and believed in.



At the conclusion of the event, Dr. Waheed Ahmad Khanday, the NSS Programme Officer, extended a heartfelt vote of thanks to all the students for their enthusiastic participation, contributing to the success of the event.
