

Environment Week 2026 was celebrated with great enthusiasm and active participation by students and faculty members of the college. The week-long programme was organized with the objective of promoting environmental consciousness, sustainable practices, and community engagement among students.

The Environment Week commenced with a **Waste Segregation Demonstration** on 20th May in which 58 students participated. Students were educated about the importance of separating biodegradable, non-biodegradable, recyclable, and hazardous waste at the source. Experts and faculty members demonstrated proper waste segregation techniques using color-coded bins. Students actively participated in the practical session and learned how effective waste management can reduce pollution and promote recycling.

A **Cleanliness-cum-Awareness Drive** was conducted at Kokernag Park on 21st May with the participation of 60 students, faculty members, and volunteers. The participants collected litter, plastic waste, and other discarded materials from the park premises. Alongside the cleanliness activity, awareness messages were shared with visitors regarding the harmful effects of plastic pollution and the importance of maintaining public spaces.

An educational visit to the **Meteorological Centre (MET) Kokernag** was organized on 21st May to provide students with practical exposure to weather monitoring and climate studies. During the visit, officials explained various meteorological instruments and their applications in weather forecasting. Students learned about climate patterns, data collection methods, rainfall measurement, temperature monitoring, and the significance of weather prediction in disaster management and agriculture.

A Painting Competition on the theme "**Environmental Protection and Sustainable Development**" was organized on 22nd May to encourage creativity and environmental

awareness among students. Participants expressed their concerns and ideas through colorful and thought-provoking artworks.

The "**Best Out of Waste**" Model Competition was organised on 25 May. It showcased students' innovation and creativity in transforming discarded materials into useful products and decorative items. Students prepared models using waste materials such as plastic bottles, cardboard, newspapers, metal scraps, and other recyclable items. The competition highlighted the principles of reuse, recycling, and resource efficiency.

A **Documentary screening session** focusing on environmental conservation and sustainability was organized for students and faculty members on 3rd June. The screening was followed by an interactive discussion session where participants shared their views and suggestions for environmental protection.

As part of Environment Week, a **Cleanliness drive** was organized ON 5th June within the premises of Government Degree College (GDC) Anantnag. Students and faculty members participated actively in cleaning lawns, and surrounding areas.

An educational visit to the **Sewage Treatment Plant (STP), Anantnag**, was conducted to provide students with practical knowledge of wastewater management and treatment processes. Students observed the operational processes and learned about the importance of wastewater treatment in protecting public health and preventing water pollution.
