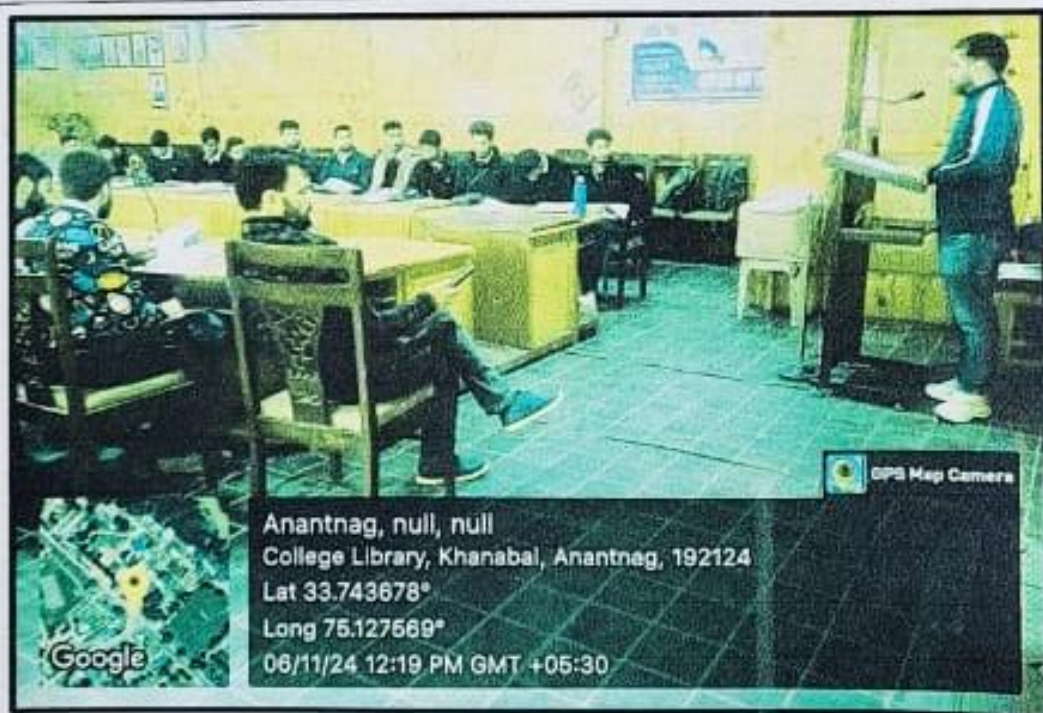

**Annual Status of Education Report (ASER)** is a nationwide household survey that captures the status of children's enrollment and learning outcomes in rural India every year.

The ASER is a citizen led survey and is conducted all over India. The 'basic' ASER survey tracks enrollment for children aged 3-16 and assesses basic reading and arithmetic of children aged 5-16. It was also started in Jammu and Kashmir. Some of the districts of Jammu and Kashmir started DLT'S (District Level Training) on 21<sup>st</sup> of October and like other the district Anantnag started the DLT on 6<sup>th</sup> of November before that an orientation cum interactive session was held with students of the Govt. Degree College Boys Anantnag. They were briefed about the ASER survey where almost 40 participants in that session. The actual district level training was started on 6<sup>th</sup> of November and was concluded on 8<sup>th</sup> of November. During the training the participants were trained how to do the actual survey in the field. After the completion of the training the students were provided survey booklets and they start field survey on 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> of November. The number of participants who joined the training program and remain in the training for three days and also did the field survey for two days was fifteen. The list of participants is below.

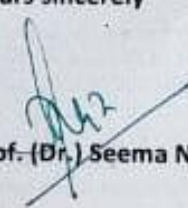

I hope this letter finds you in good health and high spirits. I am writing to bring to your attention an important initiative that requires the participation and collaboration of degree colleges across Jammu and Kashmir.

ASER is the largest citizen-led household survey of children's education in rural India. Facilitated by Pratham Education Foundation, the survey was conducted every year since 2005 to 2014, and then every alternate year. The ASER survey seeks to understand children's status of schooling and learning. In each district, the survey is carried out with the support of volunteers from local organizations and institutions. A field-based ASER typically reaches approximately 7,00,000 children (aged 3 to 16) with the help of almost 30,000 volunteers across India. In Jammu & Kashmir, 20 Government Degree Colleges & 5 local NGOs participated in ASER 2022.

The Annual Status of Education Report (ASER) has been a vital tool in assessing the quality of education in our nation. Its comprehensive data and insights have immensely contributed to educational policies and interventions. As we aim for continuous improvement in our education system, it becomes imperative for all stakeholders to actively participate in such assessments.

With ASER 2024 on the horizon, I am reaching out to request your esteemed office to issue a directive to all degree colleges in J&K, urging them to participate in this nationwide assessment. The involvement of our colleges in this endeavor will not only provide valuable data but also reflect our collective commitment to enhancing the educational landscape of our region.

Participation in ASER 2024 will entail conducting simple assessments among students, which will contribute significantly in understanding the ground realities of education in our UT. The data gathered will help identify areas of improvement and formulate targeted interventions to address challenges effectively. An active participation of students from degree colleges will improve their skills in research, sampling and data collection.

The ASER process will involve a 3-day in-person district-level training in each selected college and 2 days field work over the following weekend. Like ASER in previous years, 30 villages will be randomly-selected in each district and in each sampled village, 20 households will be randomly chosen. In a normal situation, the usual ASER survey would be conducted in September-November 2024.

I kindly request your office to issue a letter to all degree colleges under your jurisdiction, emphasizing the importance of their participation in ASER 2024. Your support and guidance in this matter will be instrumental in ensuring widespread participation and the success of this crucial assessment.

I look forward to your positive response, consideration and cooperation in this endeavor.
